<u>Math:</u>

Xtra Math if you have not passed both multiplication and division. After that, 10-20 minutes on Khan Academy-start where you left off. I'm not going to worry about the recording sheet at this point. I can see what you are working on and for how long, and you can fill in your scores when we return.

After this, go to the Pearson site (can access through Google Classroom) to watch the instructional video and complete the assignment that goes with it. The video is Lesson 14-3 (Making Line Plots) and the assignment is titled 14-03 Digital Quick Check-March 17, 2020. Both should be listed on our Google Classroom stream, so you should be able to use those links. If you are confused after watching the video on Pearson, please email me before beginning your assignment. Both the video & questions are due Wednesday morning by 8:30.

Literacy:

Reread Ch. 7 "Women in the Renaissance". The assignment with the Chapter and document is located on our Classroom Stream. During and/or after reading the chapter, fill in the chart on the document by **typing directly in it**. Do not print it out. Turn it in back in our Classroom when you are finished.

Next, you will practice correlative conjunctions (sets of words that go together) on Edulastic. It's titled "Correlative Conjunction Practice". If you feel you need a refresher, please watch the video for this that was assigned through Khan Academy last Friday. If you did not watch the video yet, go there first.

Finally, you will practice completing sentences with the root -serve-, which means to "save, protect, or serve". In our Classroom, there is an assignment posted that is titled "11.3 Root *serv*".

Science:

On a piece of paper, draw a model of where living things are found on Earth. Show how Earth's spheres (geosphere, hydrosphere, biosphere, and atmosphere) overlap each other as layers. Use colors or patterns that blend to show the overlap. Add a title and labels to your model. Before you begin, decide if you will show the entire Earth or zoom in on one small part of it.

I've added the chapters from our Science book (chapters 1-4) to our Classroom Stream so you can look back and check for details. There are additional instructions to turn in your drawing on our Classroom page that are posted along with the chapters.

Social Studies:
