**Directions:** You will create a brochure that enlightens non-citizen residents on how to become citizens of the United States. The pamphlet will include the requirements, steps of the naturalization process, explain the citizenship ceremony, explain a few duties and responsibilities of citizens of the U.S., and finally describe the ways Americans may lose their citizenship. Your brochure should be illustrated, colorful, interesting to read, creative, and neat. The more information you include, the better your brochure will be. Remember that you should always use your **own words** when summarizing information from the book! Below is a sample format for your pamphlet. If you choose not to follow the sample, please make sure your layout is easy for me to follow.
