1. **expand** – to develop (something) in greater detail; to make larger or more complete
2. **twinge** – a sudden, sharp feeling of pain, grief, shame, and so on
3. **vivid** – forming clear or lifelike pictures in the mind; lively
4. **impulse** – an internal force that causes one to act without thinking
5. **manipulative** – able to influence or control in a clever, often unfair way
6. **quaver** – a trembling or shaking
7. **intensely** - very strongly
8. **endure** – to hold up under (pain or other hardship); put up with
9. **industrious** – steady, hard-working
10. **adjoining** – located next to
11. **evidently** – clearly
12. **perilously** – dangerously, riskily
13. **antic** – an odd, silly, or comical action
14. **onomatopoeia** – the use of words that imitate or suggest the sound of what they describe
15. **repetition** – repeating certain lines, phrases, or words; to help to emphasize an idea or create a mood
