3. **lament** – to express sorrow or regret
4. **anguish** – great mental or physical suffering; misery

6. **oversight** – a careless mistake
7. **reconciled** – once again friendly, as after an argument or disagreement
8. **remorse** – a deep, painful feeling of guilt or sorrow for wrongdoing
9. **repulsive** – causing dislike; disgusting
10. **morsel** – a small portion or quantity
11. **infest** – to occur in large numbers so as to be harmful or troublesome; overrun
12. **colossal** – extraordinarily large; huge
13. **alter** – to make or become different; change
