

Your Child's Super Saint Week Details

Your child's Super Saint Week can be found on the class website calendar. Please note this special week in your family planner. The week cannot be changed. Every week is taken by a child with no extra or make up weeks. In the event of a week of snow days during your child's week, we will simply double up the next week with another student. It would be very rare for this to happen. If your child's week is a short week due to a holiday or snow day, your child's activities will be adjusted as necessary.

Monday: Your child brings in a poster or banner that highlights his/her interests and family. The poster can include photos, drawings, and any other items you wish to include. Please limit the size of the banner or poster to that of a standard poster board size. Your child's poster/banner will be on display in the classroom all week and your child will tell the class about the poster during the week.

Tuesday: Your child brings in his/her favorite book. Please record a family member reading the book on a cd. I will play the cd and show the book to the class. If you do not have the ability to record on your computer at home, Mr. Morter will schedule a recording session in the computer lab with the parent or older sibling. Please make arrangements to record with Mr. Morter two weeks or more in advance. If neither of these options will work for you, don't worry, I will be happy to simply read the book aloud! To schedule a recording session with Mr. Morter, please email me with a request to do so and I will have him contact you.

Wednesday: Your child brings in his/her favorite stuffed pet to hold and love the entire school day.

Thursday: Your child should bring in a Show N Tell Item. This should not be toy if possible. Please consider a special keepsake, a collection or souvenir from a trip. If the item is valuable or breakable, please drop the item off in the morning in the classroom instead of sending it in your child's backpack and the item can be picked up on Friday during your visit.

Friday: Please plan an activity, game, or craft to lead in the classroom. The activity, game or craft should last fifteen minutes and will be a part of our centers for the day. You will lead the activity, game or craft four times with a small group of children. Please plan to arrive in the classroom with all needed materials at 10:15. The children will be enjoying recess and we can set up and prepare. The centers will begin at 10:30 and we will conclude at 11:45. You must contact me via email at least one week in advance with your activity, game or craft plans. I must approve the activity, game or craft. If you need suggestions or ideas, please let me know.
