<p>Create a physical model of your dream house. You may use balsa wood, popsicle sticks, or other approved building materials. Make sure it is neat and represents something important to you that you can share with the class.</p>	<p>Design a new cover for the book or a movie poster for the movie The Wright 3. This must be in full color and your best work.</p>	<p>Research and report on Frank Lloyd Wright using technology to present your findings. You may create a keynote or other approved forms of technology.</p>
<p>Create a stained glass drawing using the Fibonacci Number sequence. This can be a painting, a drawing, etc. The Fibonacci sequence must clearly be shown in the artwork. You may do this on actual glass (with your parents' permission) or submit the plan for the glass on white paper. This must be full color.</p>	<p>Use the 3-D Design Studio to create a house with Frank Lloyd Wright. Present your creation to the class detailing why you chose the client, the location and the floor plan that you chose.</p>	<p>The novel, <i>The Wright 3</i>, has many examples of sequences and codes. Create your own code to use with messages. With a friend, use this code to write at least 4 messages back and forth to each other.</p>
