

Ms. Lavallee's Classroom Policies

Absent Policy

When absent, it is your responsibility to see Ms. Lavallee the day you return for missed work. If you are absent for one day, you must make up any quizzes/tests you missed the day you return after school or during a study period. If you are absent for several days, see Ms. Lavallee the day you return to discuss missing work. Work not made up within a reasonable period of time will not be accepted. **If you know in advance that you will be absent, you *must* see Ms. Lavallee for assignments *before* you leave school.**

Bathroom Policy

You must receive permission from Ms. Lavallee before leaving the room to use the bathroom. The sign out log, located next to the door, must be filled out upon leaving and returning. Abuse of bathroom privilege is highly discouraged.

Late Policy

You are expected to be in your seat by the start of class. Students who come in late without a pass will receive a detention. Students who are late to class more than three times will report to Mr. Harrington.

Detention Policy

If you are assigned a detention, you must serve it the next day unless you have a note from home stating that you are unable. In that case, you will serve the detention the next available afternoon. Students who do not report to Ms. Lavallee's classroom by 2:20 on the designated afternoon will be reported to Mr. Harrington.

Extra Help Policy

You are welcome to come for extra help Monday – Thursday after school from 2:15 – 2:50. If you come for extra help, it is your responsibility to come prepared with math materials and questions. Students who are not prepared for extra help may be asked to leave.
