The Algebra I Honors curriculum was prepared with several things in mind: (1) rigorous coursework to meet the needs of mathematically talented students, (2) preparation for Honors Geometry, Algebra II Honors, and Pre-Calculus which require a very strong background in Algebra and (3) preparation for annual assessments that include the State "End-of-Course Exam" for Algebra I Honors.
