



EXTRA CREDIT FOR SPANISH 1 STUDENTS

- 1) Find the "Avenue of Nations" (the area where booths are set up for countries across the world)
- 2) Pick up a passport at the information desk at the entrance.
- 3) Visit at least 5 Spanish-speaking booths and get your passport stamped at each booth (1 stamp per page)
- 4) On each stamped page, write down 5 things you saw or learned about the country (Be specific!)
- 5) Bring your stamped passport on Monday for a '100' as a Test grade.
