Task Sheet

___1. What is the history of the park? (Where and how did it get its name? How long has it been in existence as a National Park?) Write one or two more facts that you think your parents would be interested in.

___2. You're planning on camping...is camping available? What is the cost per day? How much will it cost for the entire week? What other expenses are involved with the park? (Entrance fees, parking, special shows, etc.)

___3. What months, days, and time is the park open?

___4. What activities are available in the park? (List 4 or 5. Don't forget to check to see if a cost is required).

___5. What kind of wildlife is seen in the park?

___6. Fuel, food, lodging expenses: You must consider the distance from your home to the park and back home; meals you will eat on the road; and if it's too far to drive in one day, lodging expenses. In some instances, you will have to fly to get there.

___7. Your family also wants to know the kinds of landforms that make this park so special. Find them and list them, describe each landform. Give any extra information that you choose.
